Meeting Minutes

12:03 – Meeting called to OrderMr Brooks – Proposed Budget Review

- With COVID, DHS was cut 2.5 teachers to compensate for online learning. Need the funding to replace classroom teachers
- Additionally, utilizing a paraprofessional to work with online students
- DHS has a 50% pass rate for online students vs District-wide 25%
- Balance of funding to replace Chromebooks & other technology needed to support COVID remote learning options

Mr Christensen – School of Life

- Original plan was to fund School of Life next year, but considering utilizing another funding stream for this or utilizing community resources to offer an equivalent course for less money that can benefit more students
- Good feedback from students on the course
- How to keep what the students are learning going throughout HS?
 - o Mentor other students who are going to attend School of Life
 - Have a campus club for students who attend (School for Cool)
 - Option for projects to be completed later

Ms Atkinson – Counseling Update

- ACT 23 Mar, register 2/3 Mar in History Classes
- Doesn't appear to be required for college for Juniors this year, but colleges will still review scores
- Counselors are working with students to lower anxiety about the test
- Mr Schweitzer on how Teachers prepare students Bell work, test taking strategies, practice tests, reading practice to help students be more prepared & less anxious about the test
- Mr Christensen on other ways students can prepare take harder courses AP, Honors,
 Concurrent Enrollment
- Mr Brooks will be taking the ASPIRE test to help gather data
