- Have already had over 1,600 appts with students and parents so far this year

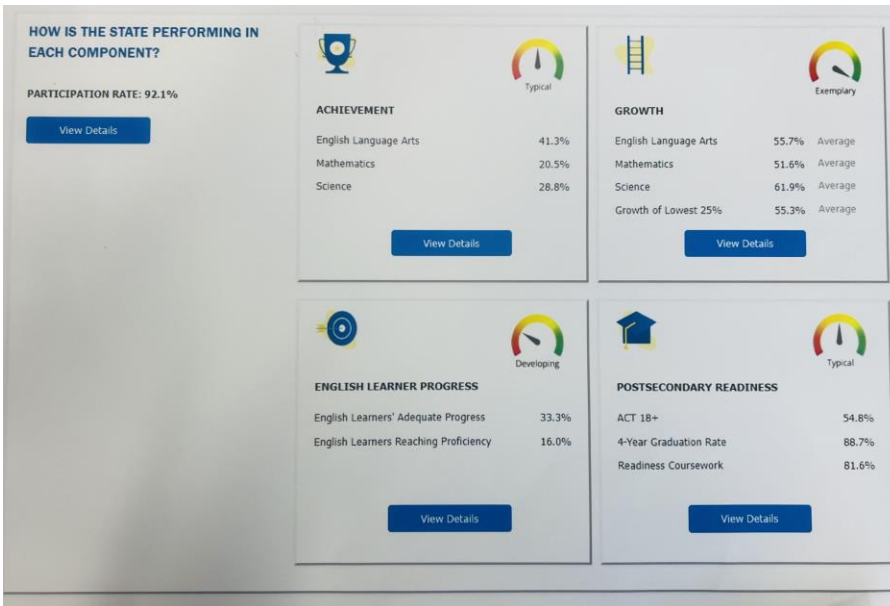
Derek Schweitzer, Language Arts Teacher, Learning Coach:

- Aspire testing results, we have one of the highest participation results... shows the results across the board, not a selected group of participants
- English Learner progress was bottom of the red last year. We have 36 students the speak 0% English. We are developing and making progress! Trust money was very helpful and will continue to be helpful
- Achievement results, need to focus on Math and Science more
- Post Secondary Readiness Results, considers ACT scores that are 18+, 54% of students scored 18+, goal to increase to 60%.

- Growth Results, working hard and growing! Measured by the mean growth rate plus our improvement rate.
- November 1st, Parent Teacher Conferences. These results will also be public beginning November 1st.
- Hoping to put more money towards programs instead of technology this year.
- 19.5 was the National Average on the ACT Test.
